

ESMBA Dress Code Guidelines

The Dress code applies to all ESMBA Competitions unless specified to the contrary, failure to adhere to the code may result in the offending player/players not being allowed to participate.

GENTLEMEN

- White shirt with collar, County tops, club tops or matching polo shirts.
- Mid grey, black, or coloured trousers or shorts. All players in a team must wear the same colour (No jeans or combats)

LADIES

- White blouse with collar, County tops, club tops or matching polo shirts.
- Mid grey, black or coloured skirts not split above the knee, culottes, trousers, or shorts. All players in a team must wear the same colour (No jeans or combats)

FOOTWEAR

- Only footwear produced by recognised bowls manufacturers may be worn on the mat and they must be changed into at the venue.

SHIRT DESIGNS

- All new shirt designs must be approved by the ESMBA Management committee for use in all ESMBA run competitions.
- Shirt designs for colour and style are generally not restricted.
- County names are permitted on the rear of the shirt, with no restrictions to size if they look in proportion.
- No nicknames or individual names are allowed on the back of shirts.
- Only National, County, Club badges are permitted to the front of the shirts with small, printed names.
- Sponsors logos and names are permitted on sleeves and back of shirt only.
- Generally, badges and logos to the front of shirts and sleeves are to fit within a 3" square
